Lesson: Podcast

**Subject: Social Studies** 

**Grade Level: Adaptable to Grades 4-12** 

Time for Lesson: Varies by class

### **Objective:**

Students will strengthen their listening and questioning skills by interviewing a person on a specific topic and coming up with a conclusive summary and understanding.

# **Materials**:

<u>Audio Recorder</u>-podcast equipment bundle, cell phone audio recording app (*Suggestion: Spotify for Podcasters*), digital voice recorder

# **Lesson Preparation:**

- <u>Interviewee</u>-who is the target perspective? (ex: family, friend, peer, colleague, youth, adult, senior, male, female, etc...)
- <u>Time Limit</u>-set a fair time length for recording the interview.
- <u>Interview Location</u>-Environment influences which type of mic is suggested for use.
- <u>List of Questions for Interviewee</u>-Number and type of questions varies on agreed time limit and topic for interview.

#### **Lesson Procedure:**

- Recording-Make sure recording light is ON! Begin interview, hear out responses and follow through all questions.
- Voices and Time Stamp-Done at the beginning or end of recording, state names and short introduction of podcast participants along with date and location of audio interview.
   Discuss on how a persons POV (point of view) can influence their answer to certain questions.
- <u>Summary and Understanding</u>-In a few words (with possible sound/music effects) have students wrap up and voice key points in the conversation and share any new knowledge or perspectives on the specified topic.

# **Evaluation:**

• <u>Constructive criticism</u>-encouraged from teachers, classmates, and peers.
